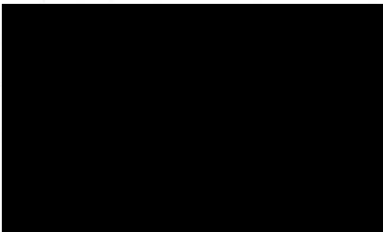

Thank you for your email of 13 January 2017 requesting the following information:

"1. Please list the number of personnel working for the Royal Navy Police at each Rank, using your most recent figures.

(For example: number of Lieutenant Commanders, number of Commanders, etc.)

2. Please provide the same personnel breakdown for the Royal Military Police.

3. Please provide the same personnel breakdown for the Royal Air Force Police.

4. Please provide the number of Senior Civil Servants (or equivalent grade) working at the Ministry of Defence.

5. Please provide the names of the roles/ grades senior to Senior Civil Servants (or equivalent grade) working at the Ministry of Defence, along with a personnel total for each grade.

6. Please provide the number of Grade 7 staff in the Fraud Defence Unit at the Ministry of Defence.

7. Please provide the roles/ grades senior to Grade 7 staff in the Fraud Defence Unit at the Ministry of Defence, along with a personnel total for each grade”

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Ministry of Defence requires further information in order to determine whether it holds any information within the scope of your request.

With regards to questions one, two and three, please could you confirm whether you require just Commissioned Ranks, or non-Commissioned Ranks or both?

With regards to question five, please could you clarify what you mean by role/grades senior to Senior Civil Servants (or equivalent grade), for example do you wish the data to include Senior Armed Forces personnel?

Once you have clarified your request, I will be pleased to consider it again.

Please remember to quote the reference number above in any future communications.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
